

PAGC Tournament Guest Policy

It is the policy of the PAGC to allow non-members (“Guests”) to play in PAGC sponsored tournaments. The purpose of the policy is to promote PAGC membership. Guest participation is limited by the following conditions.

1. Tournament participation priority will always go to existing members.
2. Guests will be permitted on a space-available basis once members have had a reasonable opportunity to enter the tournament (usually the tournament sign-up cutoff date).
3. Guests are limited to those sponsored by an existing PAGC member in good-standing.
4. Guests should be prospective new PAGC members (Regular, Senior or Junior Executive only, not Junior).
5. The sponsoring member must have registered for and be playing in the same tournament as the proposed Guest.
6. A participating Guest may compete for the same prizes as members provided he/she (1) has paid the full tournament fee and (2) has an established, current index. A Guest not wishing to participate in competition for prizes shall pay a reduced fee set by the tournament chairman.
7. A Guest may only compete once in the prize competition without being a member of PAGC.
8. PAGC reserves the right to limit the number of times a particular Guest may participate in PAGC events.
9. Guests may not participate in NCGA qualifying tournaments.
10. The tournament chairman shall determine whether to allow tournament Guests and when and how registration will be accepted. (NOTE: At present Guests may only be entered by contacting the tournament chairman for the event. Use of the GHIN site may be implemented when possible.)
